**Eligibility:** Open to students in Grades 7–12 who attend an OCDSB Day School, Night School or other OCDSB Continuing Education Programs. Students attending schools in other Boards will need to provide additional documentation prior to registering.

### All non-OCDSB students must bring the information below:

- All non-OCDSB students must have the form signed by their Day School Principal
- Proof of Citizenship and Status in Canada (ex. Birth Certificate, Passport, Permanent Resident Card)
- Proof of Address (ex. Rental Agreement, Home Cable/Internet Bill, Utility Bill, Note: Driver's Licence cannot be accepted as proof of address)
- Ontario Education Numbers (OENs) are required as well. OENs can be found on the top of any Ontario Report Card.
