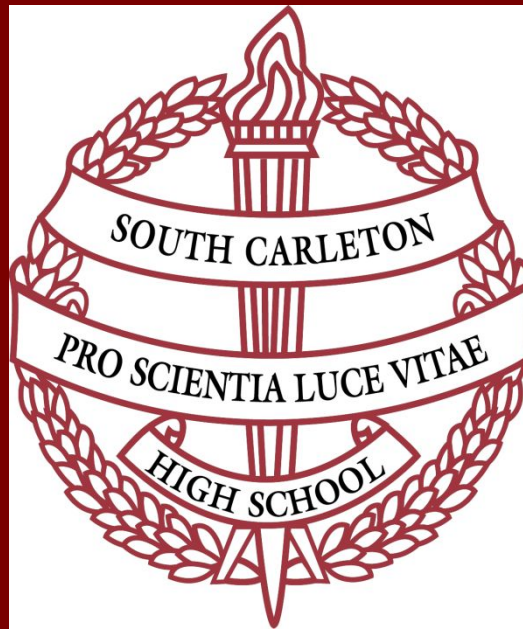

- If you are **Not Graduating**

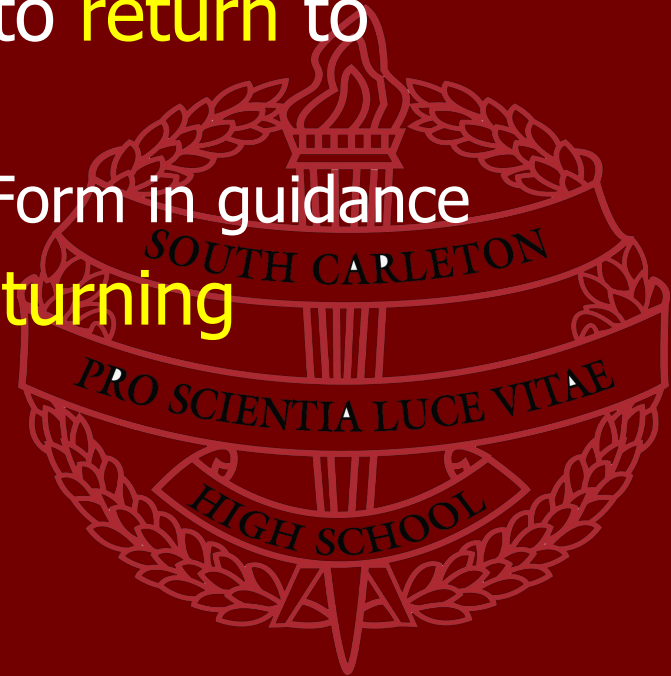
- Please make appointment to see your counsellor
