School Administration and the Prom Organizing Committee are pleased to offer you information regarding the sale of tickets for the South Carleton High School Prom for the Class 2025.

Date of Prom: Friday, May 30th, 2025 from 5:30-10:00 pm

Venue: The NAC, Canada Room

Ticket sales: April 7th - May 2nd, 2025. Prom paperwork will be posted to the Grade 12 Google Classroom and posted on our school website. Paper copies will also be available in the main office. Once the "Prom Contract" form is signed and dropped off in the main office and payment is confirmed then tickets will be distributed to the student. Pick up will be in the main office. Students will be called down when their ticket(s) are ready.

## Cost of ticket: \$130 PER PERSON (to be paid through SCHOOL CASH ONLINE) Purchase conditions:

- Each graduating student must read and complete the Prom Contract 2025 form which has all the conditions listed for the Prom.
- Each graduating student must buy their own ticket even if they are going with another student from South Carleton.
- A graduating student who is <u>not accompanied by another grade 12 student from South Carleton</u> has the privilege to ask a guest to accompany them to the Prom. An application for a guest pass must be submitted. The guest must be between the ages of 16-20, and may be a student from South Carleton in a different grade, a student from a different school (High School, College or University), or a former student. Note the school administration may refuse the sale of a ticket to a guest at their discretion.

## Security Arrangements:

As the Prom is school sanctioned, attendees are subject to the code of conduct of the school, which will be overseen by school administration, teacher supervisors, and paid-duty officers from Ottawa Police Services. As indicated in the Prom Contract 2025, the Prom is DRY. If there is any indication that a student is under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs upon entry or at any point during the event, the student will be removed, sent home, and face suspension. No reimbursement for the ticket or other costs will be given. This also applies to any student in possession of drugs or alcohol. Students and Parent/Guardian(s) should also note that under the Education Act, the Principal/Vice-Principal needs only to have reasonable belief that a student is under the influence to act, so please steer clear of disappointment by strictly avoiding any situations that may result in any suspicion from supervisors.

Other Activities:

It is important to note that South Carleton High School is only organizing the Prom being held at the NAC on May 30th and is not associated with or responsible for any other pre- or after- Prom events that may be organized by South Carleton students, parents, and/or other groups.
